

Setouchi Triennale 2019 Site Visit Tour Information

We will be holding site visit tours on the islands in the Seto Inland Sea, on which the Setouchi Triennale 2019 will be held. The tours are aimed at those who plan to submit project proposals for the Setouchi Triennale 2019. Triennale staff will lead guided tours in the following islands: Teshima, Megijima, Ogijima, Shodoshima, Shamijima, Honjima, Takamijima, Awashima, and Ibukijima.

1. Tour Dates

1st Tour: November 11 (Sat.) and 12 (Sun.), 2017

2nd Tour: November 18 (Sat.) and 19 (Sun.), 2017

2. Courses

1st Tour: [Day 1] November 11 (Sat.), 2017 Takamijima, Honjima, Shamijima, Megijima

[Day 2] November 12 (Sun.), 2017 Shodoshima, Teshima, Ogijima

2nd Tour: [Day 1] November 18 (Sat.), 2017 Awashima, Shamijima, Megijima

[Day 2] November 19 (Sun.), 2017 Shodoshima, Teshima, Ogijima

*Participation in Day 1 is optional. Participation in Day 2 is required.

4. Participants

Limited to 40 people (by order of arrival)

1. Applications will no longer be accepted once the participant limit is reached.
2. If the number of applicants exceeds the participant limit, they will be placed on the cancellation waitlist.
3. The minimum number of participants for the tour to be conducted is 5 people.

5. Participation Qualifications

Must be planning to submit a project proposal for the Setouchi Triennale 2017.

For those planning to apply as a group, only the group representative (one person) can participate in the tour.

*In principal, the site visit tours are aimed exclusively at those who plan to submit a project proposal, so there is a possibility that family members, friends, assistants, etc. may be turned down for participation in the tour.

6. Tour Fees

This fee covers on-site transportation fees (from each day's meeting place to the area for the walking tour), museum entry fees, and lunch. Accommodation fees are not included.

*For those who make hotel arrangements through the tour (as specified in "7. How to Apply"), the ferry fee for Nov. 11 (Sat.) from the tour's ending point, Takamatsu Port, to Tonosho Port is included in the Tour Fee.

10. Sites to be Visited on the Tour

Teshima : Walking tour of the Karato-Oka area, where there are works such as “Shima Kitchen,” and

travelling by bus to the Honmura, Kou, and Karato villages.

Ogijima : Walking tour, viewing the unique landscape of the traditional homes built closely together on the steep slopes.

Megijima : Walking through villages protected from strong winds and waves by stone walls called “oote,” and visiting the mountaintop “Ogres’ Cave.”

Shodoshima : Travelling around the island by bus, visiting each area to get a feel of the island’s atmosphere.

Shamijima : Walking from Shamijima Swimming Beach to Nakanda Beach, with a spectacular view of the Seto Ohashi Bridge.

Honjima : Walking from the Kasashima Village, which still retains its historical townscape, to the Tomari area with its view of the Seto Ohashi Bridge.

Takamijima : Walking through the houses lined up on the steep slopes of the Ura area and Hama area, which is nearby the Takami Port.

Awashima : Walking through the island, mainly in the area around the Awashima Marine Memorial Park, the former site of the “Awashima Sailor School,” the first sailor training school in Japan.

Ibukijima : Walking from the Maura Port, where there are many iriko (small dried sardines) fisheries, to the center of the island.

12. Important Notes

(1) Please wear clothes and shoes that are easy to move in.

Participants will travel by bus on Shodoshima and Teshima, on foot and by bus on Megijima, and on foot on the islands of Ogijima, Shamijima, Honjima, Takamijima, Awashima, and Ibukijima.

(2) Be sure to bring something to drink. Please do not throw out your trash on the islands (bring it back to the hotel with you).

(3) On some of the islands, there are very few stores, and there is a chance you will not be able to purchase drinks or everyday goods, so please be sure to bring what you need with you.

(4) The tour will be conducted in Japanese with English interpretation. However, the materials given out etc. will be in Japanese only.

(5) In the case of bad weather, there may be no choice but to change part or all of the planned activities.

(6) If part or all of the planned schedule is cancelled due to weather conditions, there will be a lecture conducted at Takamatsu Port.

(7) Even if part or all of the planned schedule is changed, in principal there will be no refund of the Tour fee.

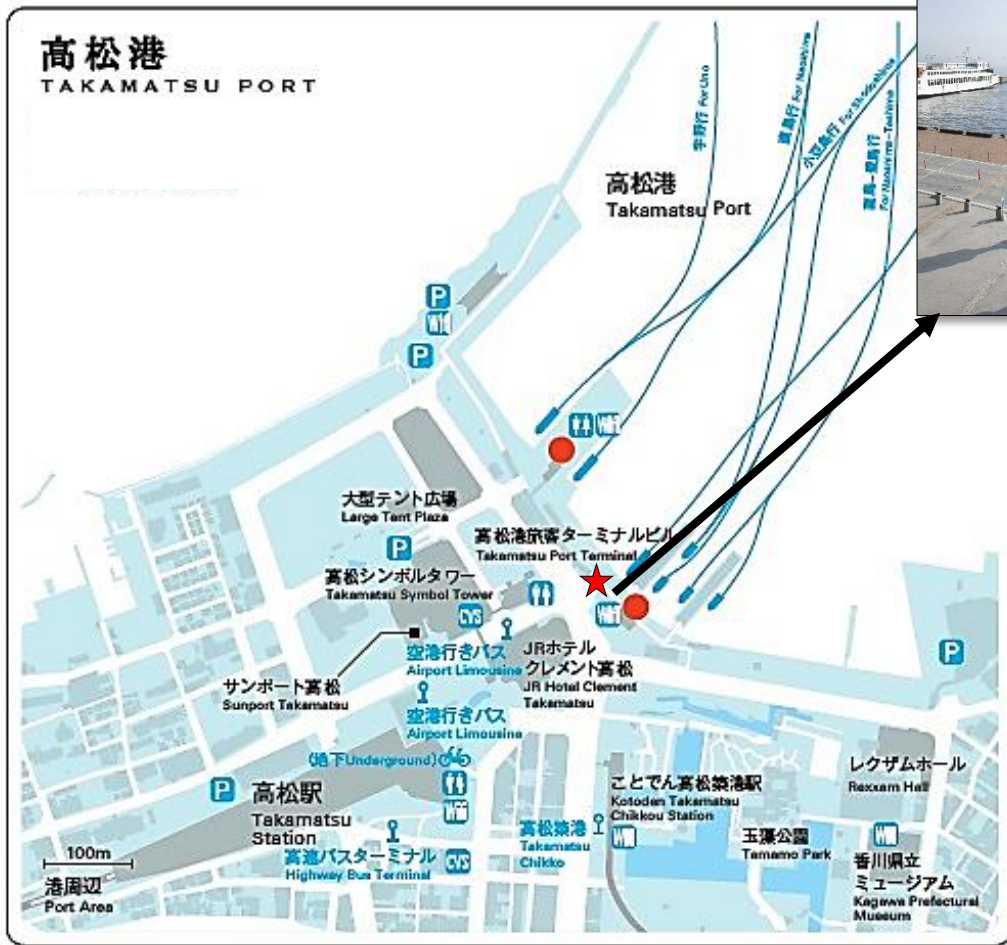

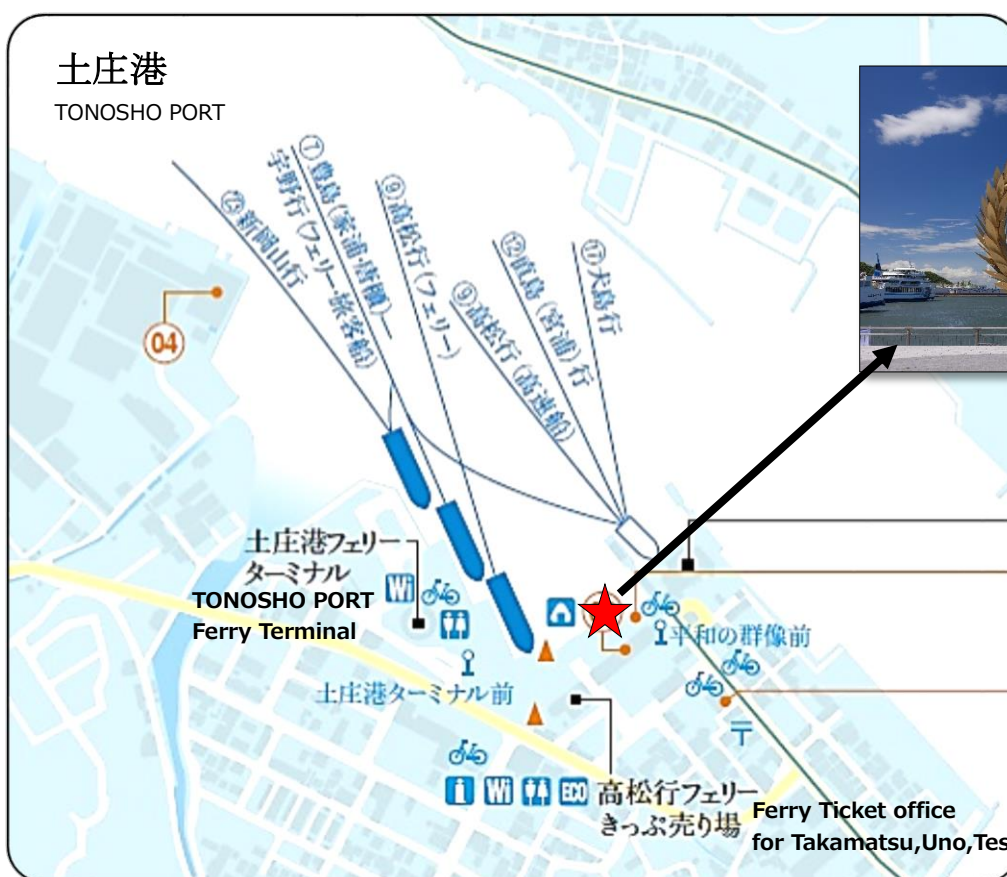
