Guidelines for Applicants

Contents	We are calling for site-specific art projects utilizing the local resources of each venue of the Setouchi Triennale 2019. Project Categories: 1. Site-specific work Works using the piers / Works with the theme of the island's nature and history Works using the alleys and streets / Works using the island's vacant house 2. Site-specific performance and event (projects including residency available as their theme) 3. Project facilitating interaction and exchange Exchange between islanders on different venues / Exchange between the artist and islanders Exchange between volunteers and visitors, etc. 4. Applicant Qualifications	Anyone that understands the objectives of the Setouchi Triennale. Anyone that can temporarily stay at the site and collaborate with local residents (as their project plan may require). **For projects in above categories 2 or 3, the selected applicants may be requested to stay on site in order to perform their project during the Triennale period. **For projects in above categories 4 or 5, the selected applicants may be requested to stay on site to manage their project during the Triennale period.
Selected Proposals	About 5 to 20 works will be selected (subject to circumstances) The selected applicants will be paid for production costs amounting from 500,000 yen to 2,500,000 yen. **The final budget will be decided based on the estimates and other data submitted by the applicant. **No other costs than the decided production fee will be paid to the applicant by the Setouchi Triennale Executive Committee, including transportation and lodging costs. **The final allocation of any profits produced by the works must be decided upon in discussion with the Executive Committee. **The startup costs of food and other projects should be discussed with the Executive Committee. **Because the islands that will be the venue for the event are part of Setonaikai National Park, applicants may be asked to alter portions of their planned projencts in accordance with the provisions of the Natural Parks Law.
Documents for Submission	 ① Application Form (on back): Attach to the front of your submission. ② Project Proposal: The following information must be included: Project title / concept / description / production process / materials / size / production and installation schedule Estimated budget (for food projects and other projects that will create revenue, the income and expenditure plan should be submitted) Visual materials such as drawings, model photographs, illustrations, etc. to help visualize the final project ③ Reference materials such as a curriculum vitae or example(s) of previous work ④ CD-ROM containing digital data of the above documents (in PDF, JPG, or MS Office [Word, PowerPoint]). ※For the text on the concept and contents of the project, it should be written in around 400 characters in Japanese or on half of an A4 sheet in English.
Format	Please combine the above mentioned documents into one volume of no more than 10 pages, A4 size paper or smaller, attached by staple. File folders, binders, or display panels cannot be accepted. However, the drawings / model photographs / illustrations etc. may be submitted in A3 size. The application must be submitted in Japanese or English. **The submitted documents will not be returned. Whether they are disposed of or kept depends on the decision of the Executive Committee. If necessary, please make copies for yourself.
Requirements	 Number of submissions: No more than 3 proposed plans per person/group Artwork conditions: No limitations on size, materials, weight, etc. Site and environment conditions: In principle, the site must be returned to its original condition. In case that the site has functions, those functions must be maintained throughout the installation period. Display period conditions: In principle, the artwork should be able to stay in good condition for the 193 day exhibition period. (events and performances excluded)

Application Procedure	Please prepay the application fee, and submit the documents that are specified in this guideline.
Screening	After Soichiro Fukutake (Setouchi Triennale General Producer) and Fram Kitagawa (Setouchi Triennale General Director) make a selection considering the conditions of the venues and the involvements of the residents, the Executive Committee will decide. First Screening: By review of application documents ① February – May 2018 (sequentially) ② July – October, 2018 (sequentially) Secondary Screening: By interview. There may be a site visit if necessary. **Those who pass the first screening will be notified directly by the Secretariat. **No inquiries on the screening results can be accepted, so please refrain from contacting us.
Announcement of Screening Results	The screening results will be announced sequentially after late March 2018. **The final results will not be notified individually. **The names of the participating artists will be announced on the official website without mention of whether they were selected through open call or not. **The final announcement of the participating artists is planned for public release around October 2018.
